Accreditation and Designation Statements

The Radiological Society of North America (RSNA®) is accredited by the Accreditation Council for Continuing Medical Education (ACCME) to provide continuing medical education for physicians.

The RSNA designates this live activity for a maximum of 94.00 AMA PRA Category 1 Credits™. Physicians should claim only the credit commensurate with the extent of their participation in the activity.

The Commission on Accreditation of Medical Physics Education Program (CAMPEP) has approved the direct transfer of *AMA PRA Category 1 Credit*™ to MPCEC on a credit-for-credit basis for medical physicists.

Through an agreement between the American Medical Association and the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada, physicians may convert *AMA PRA Category 1*Credits™ to Royal College MOC credits.

Self-Assessment Modules (SAMs)

RSNA offers self-assessment modules qualified by the American Board of Radiology in meeting criteria for self-assessment toward fulfilling requirements in the ABR Maintenance of Certification Program. Participants can earn up to 1.50 SAM credits for each SAM course in addition to the AMA PRA Category 1 Credit.

All courses designated for SAM credit at RSNA 2019 will require attendees to use their personal devices to complete the required test questions during the live session. To claim SAM credit, attendees must complete the required test questions during the live session and evaluate and claim CME for the SAM course. All SAM course credit from RSNA 2019 must be claimed before June 8, 2020.
